- Doctoral studies and synergies between EHEA and ERA



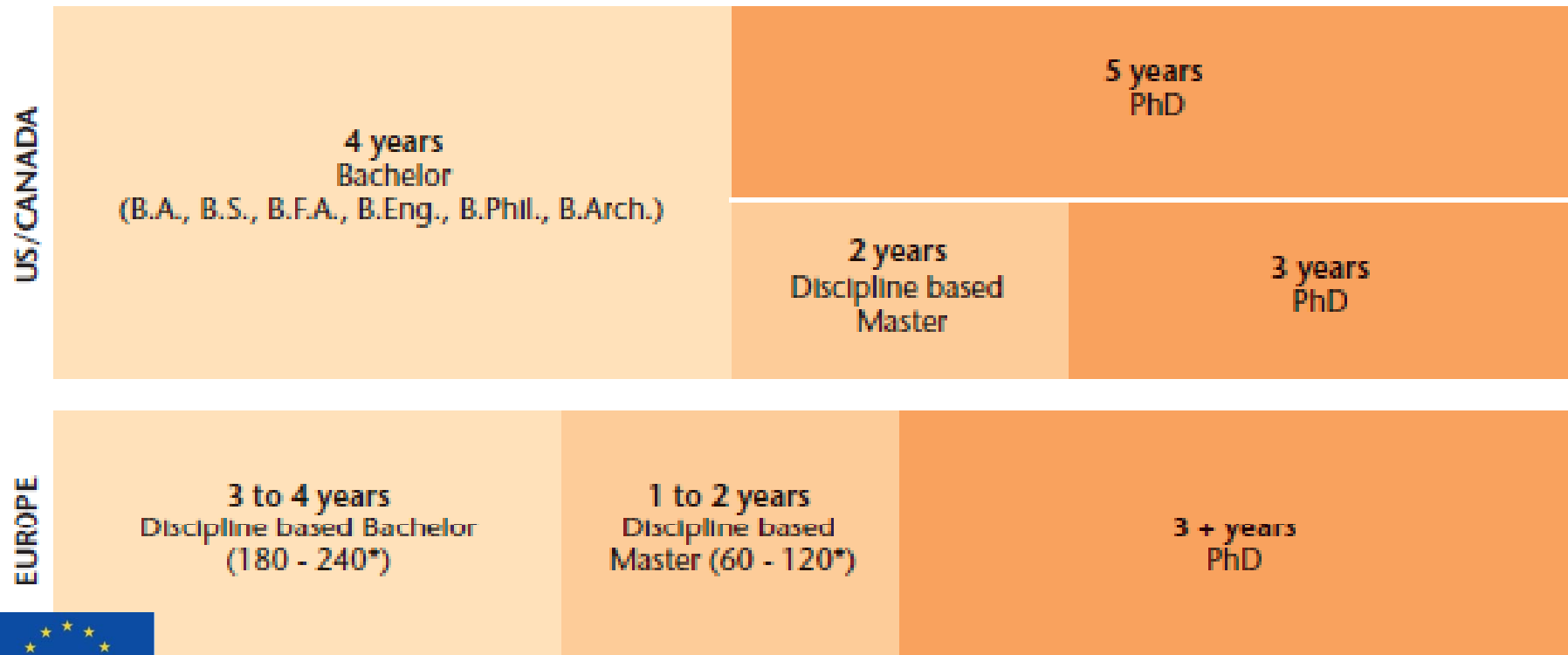
